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Dear Parents and Guardians,

Happy Monday! I hope you all had a great weekend. Thank you to our K-2 parents and teachers for attending our curriculum night event on Thursday and making it a huge success. As we continue to produce virtue in our scholars, I would love to give us all a reminder about some of our school uniform expectations regarding shoes and socks specifically.

#### Uniform Policy (Family Handbook 2019/20)

ACA has a primary objective of developing a "community of learners," dedicated to the highest standards of academics and deportment. As such, a distinctive uniform is a unifying factor within our school community. It is also a visible signature of our school to the larger community, an indicator of our unity and of our pride of purpose. This is one of the most important functions of a uniform: it identifies its wearer as part of a distinctive group with a distinctive purpose. It is a reminder to its wearer of that purpose and of one's responsibility to that group.

If a student insists on rebelling by trying to beat the dress code, it will quickly become obvious to the faculty and Headmaster. Our desire is not to squash students' individuality, but to secure their commitment to a community of learners whose purpose, while at school, is not faddish coolness, or outlandishness, but scholarship and character development. We ask not only for the student's commitment to this concept, but for the parent's as well. The uniform and dress code of ACA support and reinforce our academic goals. The uniform assists us in staying focused on the true individuality offered by healthy dialogue and the development of the life of the mind for each student.

#### Girl's and Boy's Shoes

- Color: The shoes should be solid white, or solid black.
- No colors on the shoes or soles.
- No neon or bright colored shoe laces (black shoes must have black laces and white shoes must have white laces).
- Style: Athletic (tennis, Keds) shoes.

#### Socks and Tights

- Color: Black, Blue or White.
- Length: Ankle or knee-high socks.

• Tights: Girls may wear white or navy blue footed tights. No leggings or footless tights are permitted.

Having said that, we are giving all parents whose students currently have shoes, socks, or uniforms that do not conform to dress code, until **September 27th** to act in accordance to our school's uniform policy. After this grace period, students will be held accountable.

**PHYSICALS & REGISTRATION -** must be complete in order for your student-athlete to participate. Payment must be made prior to the first competition. <u>Information on how to register and obtain the AIA Physical paperwork</u>

WINTER & SPRING SPORTS – Please register now if your student is interested in playing a Winter or Spring sport so we are better able to judge whether or not we will have a specific sport. For example, HS Boys Soccer (Winter), HS Tennis (Spring), please sign up now. There is no need to pay right away, simply select the sport your student-athlete would like to play and your name will appear on our interest lists.

ATHLETIC BAGS/BEFORE & AFTER PRACTICE PROTOCOL All student-athletes are welcome to place their athletic bags in the gym locker-rooms prior to first period. The locker-rooms will be locked during the school day and opened at 3:10pm to allow students to change for practice. Pick-up for all gym sports will be on the south side of campus at the southwest gym doors. Pick-up for all field sports will be at the parking lot north of the field.

**MIDDLE SCHOOL ATHLETICS -** MS Volleyball – All 5th and 6th graders interested in playing Volleyball will tryout on Monday, Aug. 19 and Thursday, Aug. 22 in the gym from 3:30pm-5:00pm. # **New Forgotten Lunch Policy**

If your child forgets their lunch and you are unable to bring it to them, PSO offers an alternative lunch for a charge of \$4. This is the process:

- 1. Student must call parent to notify them and get permission to receive the \$4 forgotten lunch
- 2. Student goes to the lunch counter where their name is recorded and they receive a lunch consisting of Cheerios, Horizon Organic Milk, granola bar and apple sauce.
- 3. A slip is sent home with the student notifying the parent of the lunch and instructions on how to pay the \$4
- 4. An email is also sent to the parent with the same information
- 5. After receiving 3 forgotten lunches that have not been paid, the balance will need to be paid before the student may receive another forgotten lunch.
