Parent Conferences

During the first and second quarters, we invite our parents to attend conferences right after report cards are accessible to parents. **Fifth grade is the only grade that will not have two conferences.** Fifth-grade parents will get more detailed communication regarding this from their homeroom teacher.

Our conferences for fall will be held on October 14th-16th. There will be no school for students on October 14th & 15th. Students are expected back at school on Wednesday, October 16th. Your homeroom teacher will email you a link. Please, it is mandatory for you to sign up for a slot. During conferences, our teachers plan to share your child's performance update with you. Because all performance updates will be shared during conferences, our teachers will not be writing lengthy narratives highlighting student performance this quarter. We encourage parents to come prepared with feedback and questions too. In addition, this year, our Specials teachers are having conferences too. The spaces available for meeting with Specials teachers are limited. It will be on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Message from the Health Office

I would also like to remind parents to please send any updated immunizations to <u>KMustard@archwaylincoln.org</u>. If you need to receive vaccines to update your records, fall break is a great opportunity to get to a shot clinic/physician.

Dear 5th Grade Parents,

This year the state updated their requirements for **11-year old vaccinations**. AZ state website reads, "All students must receive their *"11-year old vaccinations on or within 4 days after their 11th birthday"*. Archway Lincoln is not requiring that your child receive the vaccination within four days of their 11th birthday, however we do ask that you please schedule an appointment with your pediatrician or health care provider at your earliest convenience (if he or she has not already received their 11 year old vaccinations). The required vaccinations are **Tdap and Meningococcal**. The Meningococcal vaccine provides protection against the meningitis bacteria and the Tdap vaccine provides protection against tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis (whooping cough).

If your child has already received both of these immunizations, please forward us the most recent record or bring the updated record to the Health Office. You may also send a copy of the record to the Health Office with your student. If your child has not yet received these vaccinations, please let us know when your appointment is so we can update our records. If your student will not be receiving these immunizations, please contact us with this information. We appreciate your ongoing support and feel free to reach out to me with any questions or concerns.
